

Sky Writing Number Songs

Use these songs to help your child learn to write their numbers. We have been doing sky writing (using our fingers in the air, pretending to write the number). Now we are going to start writing the numbers on paper. Singing these songs will help students properly form the numbers. (All songs to the tune of “Skip to My Lou”

1. Come straight down and that is all (3 times). That’s how we write the number one.
2. Curl around and slide to the right (3 times). That’s how we write the number two.
3. Halfway around and around again (3 times). That’s how we write the number three.
4. Down, slide right, and cut it in two (3 times). That’s how we write the number four.
5. Down and around and give it a hat (3 times). That’s how we write the number five.
6. Slant on down and give it a curl (3 times). That’s how we write the number six.
7. Slide to the right and then slant down (3 times). That’s how we write the number seven.
8. Make an S and go back home (3 times). That’s how we write the number eight.
9. Make a circle and go straight down (3 times). That’s how we write the number nine.
0. Make an oval and that is all (3 times). That’s how we write the number zero.
